



AWHONN Intermediate Instructor Workshop

This workshop is taught by AWHONN-approved Instructor Trainers. The workshop prepares participants to teach the Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course. Content includes principles and application of adult learning theory as applicable for teaching the Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course, such as integrating principles of adult learning into the didactic and skills course components, incorporating appropriate teaching methods and strategies during the lecture, and demonstrating knowledge of the assigned components of the course during the micro-teach. Information about the administrative and operational aspects of FHM is presented. This course is the initial step for individuals who wish to become approved AWHONN FHM Program Instructors.

Learning Outcomes:

- Apply adult learning/teaching principles to the Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course
- Demonstrate entry-level proficiency in teaching selected segments of the Intermediate Fetal Course (lecture and skill stations)
- Manage classroom issues and formulate problem-solving techniques
- Identify administrative responsibilities, policies, and procedures of the Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course
- Demonstrate navigation of the AWHONN website for administrative functions
