

AWHONN Training Fast Track Options

Option 1: Participants can travel to me for courses here in Atlanta, Georgia. *(May not be cost effective if you have more than 3 nurses you may want to consider option 2)*

Option 2: Perinatal Potpourri travels to your facility to host the fast-track classes.

**Cost depends on how many participants, location/distance from major airport, number of courses requesting and time-frame for scheduling.*

Fast track option:

- **Day one** - This one-day course instructor-led course (AWHONN Intermediate workshop) consists of didactic content, hands-on skill station modules and an online integration test. Online prerequisite education is required prior to attending the one-day course. The entire course is presented in a standardized format and can be used as an educational assessment to validate the knowledge and skills of experienced perinatal clinicians. Course completion does not award certification. Participants who attend the entire course (online and instructor-led course) receive 11.25 hours of continuing nursing education (CNE) credit or 11.25 hours of continuing medical education (CME) credit. Pharmacology content is 0.5 hours of the 11.25 nursing contact hours for this course. For successful completion of the course, participants must successfully complete the online education, attend the instructor-led portion of the course, and successfully complete the skills stations and online knowledge integration test (with a score of 80% or better).
- **Day two:** The Intermediate Instructor Workshop will be taught by Perinatal Potpourri, LLC (LaShea Haynes MEd, MSN, AGCNS-BC, AWHONN Designated Instructor Trainer). During this course, each Instructor Candidate will present a micro-teach assignment. This exercise gives each Candidate the opportunity to present course material to an audience.
 - **Day two:** New version of AWHONN Intermediate Instructor Workshop contains pre-course work and reduced in-person course hours. This course provides 5.25 CEU's.
- **Day three:** The Instructor Candidates will teach the Intermediate Fetal Monitoring course under the guidance and supervision of Perinatal Potpourri, LLC (LaShea Haynes, AWHONN Designated Instructor Trainer). Contact hours are not awarded to Instructor Candidates who present the teach back course because it is a component of the Instructor Course. We can have a max of 3 new instructors for each teach-back.
