AWHONN Training Fast Track Options

Option 1: Send nurses away from your hospital to be educated - (This may not be cost effective, meet the staffing needs at your facility, and/or you may have a problem with locating a course in your area.)

Option 2: I can travel to your facility to educate your employees on your schedule.

Option 3: Fast Track - Educate nurses at your facility to become AWHONN Instructors. This will involve week long courses at your facility.

Monday & Tuesday, on the first 2 days I the Awhonn Instructor Trainer will present the two-day Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course. This course is an intermediate level program designed to review clinical practices – identification of trends, selection of appropriate interventions, communication and documentation of care. In addition to lectures over the two day period, there are skills stations.

Wednesday, the Intermediate Instructor Course only for individuals wanting to teach the Intermediate FHM Course. During the day, each of the Instructor Candidates will present a "Micro Teach" assignment.

Thursday and Friday, the Instructor Candidates will teach the Intermediate Fetal Monitoring Course under the guidance and supervision of the Instructor Trainer
